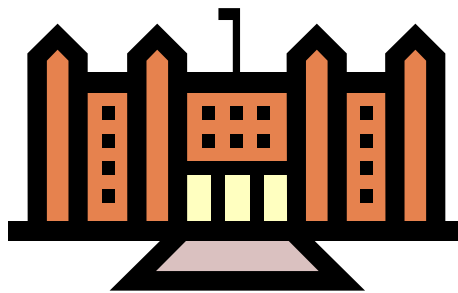


College Preparation for Students with Special Needs
