



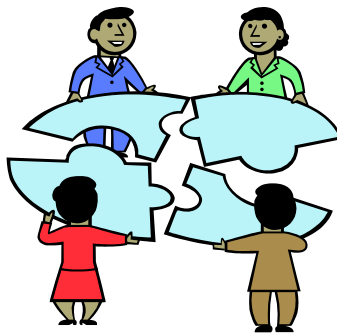
# Understanding the IEP Process for Parents of Children with Autism Spectrum Disorders
